

Robo Blocks Usage FAQ

What is the maximum number of words that can be set in the Robo Blocks ‘Say’ module?

The maximum number of words that can be set in the ‘Say’ module is 300 (including punctuation). If you can't meet your users' needs, you can stack multiple “Say” modules.

Can Robo Blocks delete uploaded apps?

No, only administrators have access to delete apps.

What browsers are required to open the Robo Blocks website?

Depending on the device system, it can be divided into:

Google Chrome is recommended for Win/Mac/Android. 2.

Safari is recommended for iPad.

What is the difference between Robo Blocks and Choregraphe?

The differences are:

Robo Blocks is mainly for primary and secondary schools, through the use of Robo Blocks on Pepper programming education, to stimulate children's enthusiasm for robotics learning and exploration. 2.

Choregraphe is aimed at high schools and colleges, and supports Python programming to implement complex scenarios, providing command boxes such as speech, action, movement, recognition, and emotion.

Is there a limit to the number of rooms that can be created with Robo Blocks?

There is no limit to the number of rooms that can be created. If a user's app is uploaded to a large unit of rooms such as an entire school/grade level at the same time, it is considered that the management and operation of the app will become complicated, so it is recommended that rooms are created in small groups or lessons.

Use a tablet to save files on Robo Blocks.

If you are using an iPad, check that you are using the Safari browser and for Android tablets, check that you are using the Chrome browser. Please allow pop-up windows. If the popup window is blocked, you may not be able to save the file.

When I run ‘Send to Robo’ in Robo Blocks, can I overwrite the previous application with the same icon and the same application name?

No, you cannot overwrite the application. When you run ‘Send to Robot’, it will recognise it as a different app each time.
